

Greetings from the Iowa Association of Business and Industry (ABI) Foundation!

Our annual **Business Horizons** program brings together students (grades 9-12) from across the state and provides them with unique, hands-on experience in the world of business and entrepreneurship. Participants are placed in teams and tasked to launch a mock business that solves a real-world problem. Together, they take part in business competitions, attend workshops and business visits, and develop essential future-ready skills. Students leave with a better understanding of their strengths, renewed self-confidence, and a clearer vision of how their passions relate to future opportunities.

The student giving you this letter attended the program in 2025 and is pursuing an opportunity to return this year as a **Business Horizons Ambassador**, an important member of our volunteer staff. The application process requires each student to submit an online application and a recommendation from someone in their school.

Ambassadors act as liaisons between the staff/volunteers and the student participants. They must have a high level of maturity and strong leadership skills. The following qualities are also important for this role:

- ✓ **Interpersonal skills**: Ambassadors must be able to communicate effectively and in a positive, professional manner with a variety of individuals in both group and one-on-one situations.
- ✓ Team-focused: Ambassadors must exhibit a spirit of cooperation, responsibility, and the ability to work for group success over individual gain. Ideal candidates know when to lead and when to play a supporting role.
- ✓ **Sound Judgment**: Ambassadors must model and reinforce mature behavior and decision-making skills, even when "unpopular." These students must be quick problem-solvers and able to complete tasks with little direction or supervision.
- ✓ **Great Attitude & Energy**: Ambassadors must act as role models and maintain positive, can-do attitudes each day. They must display strong physical and mental stamina. Workdays are often long!
